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**Procedures for the allocation of places in Year 1 at Lycée Français Charles de Gaulle (South Kensington, André Malraux - Ealing, Marie d'Orliac - Fulham, Ecole de Wix - Clapham) for pupils coming from a partner school of the AEFÉ London network**

1. The allocation of a place in Year 1 for pupils coming from a partner school is carried out according to available places in one of the schools of the Lycée Français Charles de Gaulle following the placing of pupils from the Lycée's nurseries.

2. We advise parents apply to at least two schools and specify their preferred school. If we are unable to satisfy all demands, priority will be given to pupils supported by a AEFÉ Scholarship.

**Procedures for the allocation of places to Year 7 to the Lycée Français Charles de Gaulle for pupils coming from a school with an agreement with the AEFÉ or a partner of the AEFÉ network in London as well as for pupils from the bilingual section of Wix Primary School - bilingual section shared with Ecole de Wix and for pupils from the Fulham Bilingual Holy Cross – bilingual section of Holy Cross shared with Marie d'Orliac school.**

1. Only pupils leaving schools of the London AEFÉ network which do not have secondary classes may be allocated a place in Year 7 at the Lycée Français Charles de Gaulle.

2. All pupils from linked schools belonging to the London network may choose one of the 4 schools offering Year 7 places (the CFBL, the Lycée International de Londres, the Ecole Jeannine Manuel and the Lycée Français Charles de Gaulle). Each application must be in the form of an appropriate application form sent to the school in question. In addition, parents must complete a form indicating their order of preference.

3. For our admissions an admission committee (Year 7) where all the Headteachers of the French schools concerned (receiver and sender) are invited, on the 11th of December 2018.

4. Available places will be offered to applicants from AEFÉ partner and/or linked schools in London after the re-enrolment of LFCDG's existing students.

5. Order of priority is given as follows for admissions to the Lycée Français Charles de Gaulle for applicants from AEFÉ partner and/or linked schools in London:

a) Pupil supported by a scholarship from AEFÉ.

b) Sibling(s) currently attending the Lycée Français Charles de Gaulle in Years 2-12 in 2018-19 with the sibling remaining at the school in 2019-20.

c) The number of years of attendance in the AEFÉ network in London for applicants in Year 7. Priority will be given to those who started at nursery level, then Reception, Year 1 and so on...

d) The closeness of the date of birth of the applicant to the key date of birth chosen by random ballot every year before applications are opened. For 2019-2020 that date is 8th of October.. If the school can only assign a part of the pupils with a seniority of presence at a given level (case c) we will apply (d) to decide between them. Example: The admissions committee reaches the end of the possibilities for some of the pupils enrolled since level X in their school because availability is inferior to demand. The admissions committee will distribute the places depending on the proximity of the child's date of birth to the pivot date.

**Procedure for admission of Year 11 pupils from CFBL to the Lycée Charles de Gaulle**

Only CFBL pupils from Year 10 who have a sibling at the Lycée and who will still be attending in 2019-20 will be able to apply to the Lycée Français Charles de Gaulle, as well as those who are eligible to a French scholarship. Available places will be allocated after the re-enrolment of LFCDG's existing pupils.
